



## Dirksen Derby Night Session snowboard event rides into Hoodoo March 24-25

The Derby Night Session is a two-night snowboard event and Saturday night race at Hoodoo Ski Area on March 24-25. Ride on a course designed by X-Games bronze medalist and Patagonia Snowboard Ambassador, Josh Dirksen, who has appeared in films by Teton Gravity Research, Warren Miller, Leeward Cinema, etc.

There is a cap of 120 racers in the Saturday night race. The top 25% placers in each division qualify for the Dirksen Derby 10 at Mt. Bachelor in December 2017.

**Registration:**

\$20.00 entry fee for all divisions. All practice sessions are free and open to all. All racers must sign liability waivers to participate on Saturday. Hoodoo will offer a special \$22 afternoon event ticket valid from noon-9 p.m.
